**Antiseptic Fruit Trees**

The operation of cleansing the bark of fruit trees, should be performed in early spring, as well as in summer. The rough, loose bark of the tree, is scraped off, as well as moss and other parasites. The bark should then be covered with the following mixture, as high as the trunk will reach, with an ordinary long-handled white-wash brush: 5 pounds white oil soap, 1 pound fine salt, 1 pound fine lime, 2 pounds potash, 2 ounces salitric acid, dissolved in water, to give to the consistency of cream, and thoroughly rubbed upon the bark.

Any kinds of insects are kept from reaching by a solution of white oil soap, and many such are resident in the crevices of the bark, and are destroyed by it. The fine sand is intended to scratch the outer coating of the bark, and thus assist the other ingredients for more perfect action. The potash and nitric acid will decompose the surface of the bark, so that during the summer, when it will be thrown off by the healthy action of the growing bark. If the above mixture be applied dry weather, it will become so hard as to remain during the winter, and thus have time to perform its duty. Trees with much moss, or as the plum, many of the cherries, etc., should be rubbed with a rough woollen cloth in a few hours after applying this mixture, this rubbing will assist in cleaning the surface as perfectly, as to give the bark an improved and more healthy surface.

Trees so cleansed are not so likely to be visited by insects as those left with their natural surfaces. Indeed we have never known a tree to exhibit the disease called "canker," the surface of the bark, which had been so treated, being so healthy in the spring. The cherry, apricot, peach and nectarine, are subject when left to their natural state, to a disease called "canker," which has usually been attributed to too rich or too moist a soil, and under drainage and slitting the bark, (using the knife, as the usual remedy), the disease is cured. This is an expensive, more troublesome, and often impossible, when choice trees are planted, and the best remedy is to use the above mixture, which is cheap, and easily applied, causing exfoliation of gum and consequent canker. In any case, a few applications of soap to the surface of the bark, will remove the disease, and the mixture before recommended may be applied slightly warmed, and is required to soften the bark of a hide-bound tree.
