Kristy Stouct came in 14th with a time of 25:02, Lucas' Sarah Keppler finished 16th with an effort of 25:13, and Jody Eichelbeger's 21st place time of 25:37 led Hillsdale. All three schools did not field enough runners to compete as a team.

Northmor topped the seven complete boys teams with 37 points, with Aron Fraizer adding a sixth place effort of 18:38.

Clear Fork's boys squad took second, led by freshmen Brad Palmer and Joe Hamilton. Palmer finished at 18:00 to take second place, and Hamilton came in fourth with a time of 18:22.

Loudonville finished third, sparked by Jason Neubig's first place finish and time of 17:58, edging Clear Fork's Palmer by a mere two seconds.

Troy Gilmore (17th, 19:50) and Geoff Ball (22nd, 20:19) led Hillsdale to a fifth place finish. Chris McClontock topped Plymouth with a an 18th place time of 20:01, while Lucas' Charles Toms came in fifth with a time of 18:35.
