

# Long Runs Mark 46-14 Shelby Win At Galion

## Tigers Held Scoreless In First Half

GALION—Long runs and good blocking brought the Shelby high school Whippet gridmen a 46-14 Northern Ohio league victory over the Galion high school Tigers at Heise park athletic field here last night. It was the Tigers' second loop setback, Crestline taking an 18-13 decision a week ago Friday.

Shelby's first tally came in the initial quarter when McFarland recovered the pigskin on Galion's 30-yard stripe and scampered around right end for a touchdown. The kick for the extra point was no good. The second Shelby TD came when Moore took a reverse from McFarland and raced 53 yards to pay dirt. Newland's kick was good.

The third Shelby TD in the first quarter resulted when Wilson intercepted a Galion pass on his own 40-yard line and sped the 60 yards to the goal line. Newland again added the extra point as Shelby enjoyed a 20-0 quarter lead. Shelby scored again in the second quarter as Fullback L. Paine plunged two yards for a touchdown. The attempted kick was wide with Shelby boasting a 26-0 halftime margin.

In the third quarter Shelby again tallied as Wilson faked a reverse to McFarland and romped 75 yards to score. The try for point failed.

Galion broke into the scoring column in the third quarter with Mansperger erasing the final 30 yards to cross the Shelby goal. Schutler's kick was good to make the third quarter score 32-7.

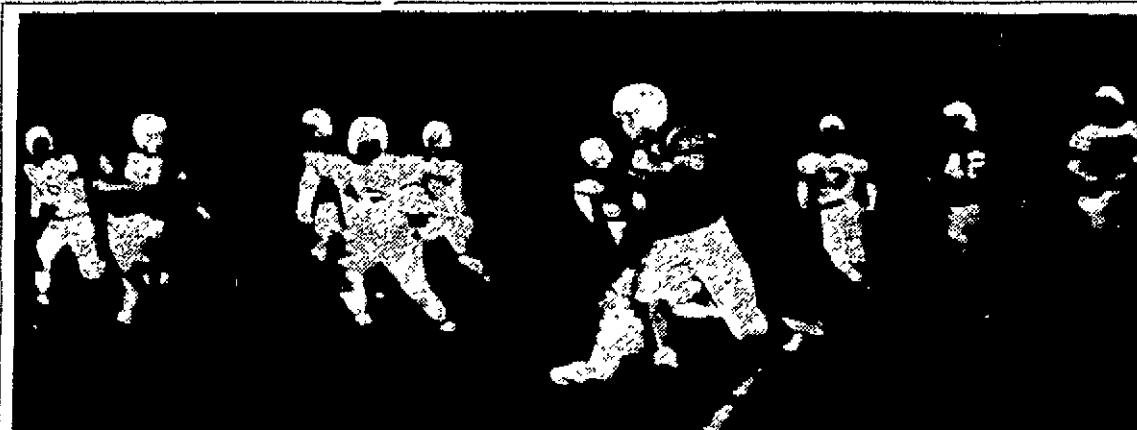
