

'Old Pros' Spahn, Ford Have It When It Counts

Milwaukee Lefty Hurls No-Hitter; Pirates Lose

The big league pennant races may eventually go to the young and the swift this year but it won't be the fault of two great old pros named Warren Spahn and Whitey Ford.

Both have lost a lot of the "hop" on their fast balls but 39-year old Spahn and 32-year old Ford demonstrated Friday night that they're still two of the best clutch pitchers in the business.

Spahn, battling to keep the Milwaukee Braves' faint pennant hopes alive in the National League, pitched his first no-hit

ter, gained the 287th win of his career and set a major league mark of 11 20-win seasons by a left-hander when he topped the Philadelphia Phillies, 4-0.

Ford, answering Baltimore manager Paul Richards' suggestion that his arm might be "dead," beat the Orioles for the fifth time this season, 4-2, and enabled the New York Yankees to take a one-game lead in the American League.

The Braves moved into second place, 5½ games from the lead with only 12 games to play, when the Cincinnati Reds edged the front-running but faltering Pittsburgh Pirates, 4-3. And the Yankees went three full games ahead of the third-place Chicago White Sox, who bowed to the Detroit Tigers, 4-3.

The San Francisco Giants knocked the St. Louis Cardinals into third place, 6-2, and the Los Angeles Dodgers scored a 5-4 victory over the Chicago Cubs in other NL games. The Washington Senators downed the Boston Red Sox, 3-0, and the Cleveland Indians defeated the Kansas City Athletics, 4-2, in other AL action.

Ford carried a 4-0 lead into the night inning but faltered with two out and Bobby Shantz retired the final Baltimore batter.

Eddie Kasko's three-run double in the second inning and Gordon Coleman's run-producing single in

Perry Wins

Grant Suspended Balance Of Season For Leaving Park

CLEVELAND (UPI)—Although the Cleveland Indians are sagging a half game out of the first division today, the club probably will see two new marks set this year.

Slim Jim Perry, the righthander who copped his 17th victory of the season with a 4-2 decision over the Athletics Friday night, has equaled a club record of serving up home run balls.

Perry was tagged for his 32nd of the year when Bill Tuttle gave the Athletics a short-lived lead in the opening frame with his seventh four-bagger of the season.

Perry, who has a chance of a 20-game season with three more starts, could also establish a new home run record in three more starts. The mark he died Friday night was set by Eddy Wynn in 1956.

Johnny Romano set a new club record for catchers when he hit his 15th homer, one of three circuit blows for the Tribe. Jim Hegan held the old record with 14 in 1948 and the same number in 1950.

Two Others Connect
The other Cleveland homers were slammed by Mike De La Hoz and Tito Francona.

De La Hoz led off the third with his fifth of the season. Romano followed with his 15th, and two outs later, Francona walloped his 16th over the right field fence for what turned out to be the winning run.

The Tribe scored its final run in the sixth on a walk to Francona, a bunt single by Ty Cline and a single by Woodie Held.

All of the Cleveland runs came off Ned Garver, who lost his ninth against only two runs.

The Athletics failed to score again until the eighth. Hank Bauer and Norm Siebern singled and Dick Williams doubled to send Bauer home.

Perry got a hand from Johnny Klippstein, who came on to retire the last two men in the eighth and halt the Kansas City rally.

Jack Harshman (2-4) was to face either Dick Hall (7-12) or Johnny Kucks (4-9) today in the second game of the series.

Manager Jimmy Dykes knocked

pitcher Jim Grant off the payroll Friday night for the balance of the season in a disciplinary move. Grant was suspended for leaving the stadium without permission.

Dykes called to the bullpen in the second inning and ordered Grant and Dick Stigman to warm up. He was told that Grant had left the stadium.

Bullpen Coach Ted Wilks told Dykes that he and Grant had had an argument and Grant returned to the dressing room.

Dykes said he walked into the clubhouse to talk to Grant during the second inning but the pitcher already was gone.

"I suspended him because he didn't report to me. There is no excuse for doing what he did," Dykes said.

General Manager Frank Lane gave his approval to the action. Grant explained that he was singing the national anthem when the argument developed with Wilks.

He said when he got to one part of the anthem, he sang instead "This land is not so free, I can't even go to Mississippi."

Grant said the remarks were made in fun, Wilks called him a name and he got mad.

"I told him that Texas is worse than Russia," Grant said. Wilks is a Texan.
