

Ontario, Clear Fork Still Unbeaten In JAC

Fredericktown Nips Plymouth, 15-14

The three strongest football powers in the Johnny Appleseed Conference escaped upsets last night.

Unbeaten co-leaders Ontario and Clear Fork (both 8-0 and 9-0) experienced severe tests from Crestview (1-7 and 2-7) and Crestline (4-4 and 5-4).

Ontario had to work to take a 26-6 victory over Crestview in a game that was closer than the score indicates.

Clear Fork managed to score twice in that last period to eke out a 22-24 win over Crestline which led by 10 points early in the fourth quarter.

Fredericktown (6-2 and 7-2) won a 15-14 decision over Plymouth (3-5 and 3-6) with a touchdown in the waning seconds.

Today Loudonville (4-3 and 5-3) visits Lucas (0-7 and 1-7) at 2 p. m., while Northmor (2-5 and 3-5) meets Lexington (2-5 and 3-5) at Bellville at 8 p. m.

Ontario and Clear Fork meet in the championship game next Friday at Bellville.

Clear Fork...

CRESTLINE — In one of the most exciting games of the year, Crestline led the invading Clear Fork Colts until Roger Bowers managed to squirm into the end zone with just 1:45 left to cap a do-or-die march for the Colts before 3000.

Crestline scored shortly after the game opened, after taking a Colt fumble on the second scrimmage play on the Clear Fork 35.

After two short runs, Rocky Alt fired an 18-yard strike to End Joe O'Heron and on the next play, Sophomore halfback Rick Rita scampered nine yards to score.

The Colts came right back to score a first quarter TD with a grueling 65-yard march in 13 plays. Ken Hollar scored on a one-yard plunge.

With only 0:34 left on the clock O'Heron intercepted a desperate Clear Fork pass and handed the ball laterally

to Jeff Huml who raced 30 yards to the Colt 10. With only 19 seconds left, Alt lofted a 10-yard, pay-off pass.

The Colts came back out of the dressing room and drove 70 yards at the opening of the second half. Ken Hollar scored on the 13th play from the one.

At this point Alt cranked up and drove the Bulldogs 68 yards. He scored from the one.

Trailing 24-14 in the last period, Clear Fork received a break when Alt slipped and fumbled on an attempted pass.

Clear Fork then drove 48 yards to a score with Hollar going over from the one.

Then after an attempted on sides kick, Clear Fork drove 58 yards for the final TD.

Sieve Walker rushed for 120 yards and Hollar added 104. Alt hit on 11 of 25 passes for 135 yards.

ONTARIO — Ontario had to survive a fired-up Crestview effort to ice its 22nd straight victory and move into next week's key battle with Clear Fork.

The Cougars struck first to startle the Parents' Night crowd. Fullback John Meeting set up the Crestview score as he raced 15 yards to the Ontario 30 on a punt return. Four plays later the 150 pound senior ran for the touchdown from the 19.

The stunned Warriors came back in the second half, scoring first on a 57-yard drive. Halfback Jim Herrick raced the

final 23 yards and Halfback Larry Easterday added the two-point conversion to put the Warriors in front for the first time.

Fullback Jack Boyd inflicted most of the fourth-quarter damage. The 225-pound block-buster scored on runs of one and 17 yards and capped both his touchdown runs with two-point conversion romps.

Boyd, a senior, now has tallied 66 points in JAC play. Boyd was tied for fifth in league scoring going into last night's game.

The final Ontario touchdown was set up by Sophomore Doug Strohminger, as he raced 26 yards to the Crestview 19-yard line.

Ontario picked up its other two points when End Ken Rinehart nailed McFadden in the end zone on a kick off for a safety.

The scrappy Cougars held Ontario to 110 yards rushing in the first half, but Ontario finished with 252 yards on the ground. The Warriors, however, failed to click on any of their four passing attempts.
