FINDLAY — Curt Everman's sparkling 75 sparked Norwalk's high school golf team to a second-place finish in the Class AA District tournament at Hillcrest Golf Course Friday, qualifying the Trunkers for next weekend's state championships in Columbus.

Everman shot a 36-39 round for co-medalist with Eastwood's Gary Gardner, a member of the district champs.

RESOLUTION APPROVING DETAILED PLANS, SPECIFICATIONS AND ESTIMATES OF COST OF CERTAIN ADDITIONAL EQUIPMENT NECESSARY FOR THE MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION OF THE ERIE COUNTY SANITARY LANDFILL, DECLARING THE NECESSITY OF THE ACQUISITION OF SUCH EQUIPMENT, DETERMINING THE METHOD OF PAYMENT, FIXING THE TIME AND PLACE OF HEARING, OBJECTIONS TO THE ACQUISITION OF SUCH EQUIPMENT, AND ORDERING NOTICE OF SUCH HEARING.

The Board of County Commissioners of Erie County, Ohio, met this 2nd of October, 1978, in Regular Session with the following members present: Mr. Vaughn M. Dee, Mr. Gustafson, Mr. Dee, and Mr. Gustafson.

The game was match point duplicate and South felt that he had carefully shown West that, South, had started with one spade, six hearts, two diamonds and four clubs.

Nevertheless, West ducked the spade lead that followed without a quiver. South called for dummy's jack and the defense got

their two spade tricks. South was mad but not too mad to congratulate West on his play of the low spade and to ask him how he had worked it out.

West, an old campaigner never said a word except that he felt that the score for six hearts bid and made against him would have been well below average and that he wanted to give him self every chance for a really good score.

We think West had another reason for his play. It was that third round of trumps that South had played. He had no reason for that play except to make sure that West would know that South had started with six trumps.
