Pruitt Ready For Chiefs

KANSAS CITY, Mo. (UPI) -Greg Pruitt of the Cleveland Browns has been hobbled for the last five weeks with leg and hip injuries. But all the whirlpool treatments in the world couldn't do as much for Pruitt's return to good health as the appearance of the Kansas City Chiefs on the Cleveland schedule.

Pruitt rushed for 100 yards in each of the first two games this season but suffered a severe contusion to his left leg on that second weekend against Cincinnati. That forced him to sit out an entire month.

Pruitt returned to the starting line-up against Pittsburgh last week but was, predictably, rusty and ineffective. He gained only eight yards in six carries as Cleveland fell, 34-14, for the third time in the last four

"When you're accustomed to running every day and then you

have to stay off your leg for two weeks, you lose all the tone and your leg becomes weak," Pruitt said. "I tried running on it after three weeks but I shifted all my weight to my right side to alleviate the pain on the left side. That threw my whole framework out of place. In doing so, I strained the muscles in my hip.

'My style of running is such that I need to be at 100 percent. I don't run straight ahead; I do a lot of cutting. I put a lot of pressure on my knees, ankles and hips. Some people can come back at 80 or 90 percent, like fullbacks who run straight ahead. But that's not my style. I have to accelerate, deccelerate and go in different directions."

Cleveland Coach Sam Rutigliano, to no one's surprise, announced that Pruitt would again start Sunday when the Browns travel to Kansas City. Even at 50 percent, the former Oklahoma star could be expected to top the 100-yard barrier against the Chiefs.

That's because Pruitt has owned Kansas City over the last four years like no other running back in the league.

Pruitt has had 14 career 100yard games and three of them have come against Kansas City He had a career high 214-yard game against the Chiefs in 1975 and a season-high 153-yard game in 1977.
