# Plymouth's 3 wins match total for last four seasons

GALION - The Big Red of Plymouth are truly on a "Roll" as they recorded their third win of the season Friday, downing Northmor 35-0.

First-year mentor, Dick Roll, saw his squad record its second shutout in a row, the first time a Plymouth squad has been able to do that since the opening two games of the 1970 season.

The 35 points scored by the Big Red is their highest point production since the 1969 campaign when they downed Crestview 46-12 in the third game of the

Thes third victory of the 1983 season equals their total number of wins over the past four years (3-34-1).

McKenzie, a halfback, was an offensive guard in 1982.

McKenzie closed out the first stanza scoring with a 27-yard field goal at the 4:23 mark.

McKenzie then tallied a touchdown at the 10:12 mark of the second period as he went in from 10 yards out.

With time running out in the first half, Bradley Hampton fired a 44 yard aerial to Darren Branham with just one tick remaining on the scoreboard. McKenzie closed out the scoring with runs of 34-yards in the thirdquarter and 85 in the

The Plymouth defense also played an important "roll" in the contest as they held Northmor to just one yard rushing and 35 yards in the air on a 4-of-24 night.

This is the best start for Plymouth since 1978 when they opened with four straight wins before losing to Danville 24-0. That year they finished with a 7-3 mark, their last winning cam-

Plymouth will be at home Friday as they begin Firelands Conference play against Monroeville (2-1).


