Dendinger leads Trojans with 4 TD's, 232 yards

St. Paul loses without star running back, 18-13

South Central repaid Northmor in a big way Friday for the embarrassing 41-0 loss they suffered in the season opener at Galion last year. Using a sensational game by halfback Eric Dendinger, the Trojans rolled to a 35-13 victory at home.

In other games played by Firelands Conference teams, Keystone edged Norwalk St. Paul 18-13, and New London was trounced by Rittman, 30-6.

Northmor jumped out a 13-0 lead in the first quarter, and South Central coach Bill Lewis said to be fearing a repeat of last year's disaster.

But the Trojans scored once in the second quarter and twice each in the third and fourth to roll to an easy victory behind Dendinger's tremendous performance.

Dendinger scored four of the touchdowns, scoring from 1, 12, 18 and 37 yards, while Mike Tuttle did the rest. Tuttle scored from one yard out for a touchdown, and added all five extra points.

Dendinger, who finished with 232 yards in 23 carries, scored 24 points, while Tuttle scored the Trojans' other 11 points.

Norwalk St. Paul, minus its biggest offensive threat, fell to a veteran Keystone squad, allow-

ing the hosts to score on three long touchdown runs.

Keith Shumate, who gained over 1,000 yards for the Flyers last season, pulled a muscle earlier in the week during practice and was forced to sit out the game.

St. Paul led 13-6 at halftime, as quarterback Brad Alge scored touchdowns from one and three yards out and added the kick after the first score. The kick failed after the first TD.

Rod Fair had scored on a 58-yard romp in the first quarter for Keystone, but the kick was also missed.

The Flyers broke out top with their second score, but couldn't score again in the second half, while Keystone put two touchdowns together, scoring on TD runs of 21 and 78 yards.

Keystone finished the game with 280 yards rushing, while getting just 10 yards passing in completing one of three attempts. St. Paul had 94 yards rushing and 140 yards passing.

Meanwhile, the New London Wildcats are still looking to give Bob Hasseman his first victory as coach. After suffering through an 0-10 season last year, the Wildcats were dominated Friday at Rittman.

Tim Wise scored on a one-yard for New London, the touchdown coming in the fourth quarter after Rittman had scored all 30 of its points.
