

Plymouth 27 Crestline 26

CRESTLINE — A dramatic finish seems to be the order of the day when Plymouth and Crestline get together.

And, Friday was no exception as Plymouth held on for a 27-26 win in the season opener.

Last year, the Big Red also prevailed in a 34-30 thriller. Prior to that, the two had not met since 1976 and that game ended with Plymouth prevailing, 13-12.

It appeared Plymouth was on the way to a rout after assuming a 13-0 lead at halftime and moving ahead, 20-0, early in the third period.

But, the Bulldogs rallied with three touchdowns within a six-minute span and the two were deadlocked at 20-20 heading into the final period.

With 8:31 left to play, Jason Robinson picked off a Crestline pass and returned 57 yards for a score and Randy Myers booted the all-important PAT as Plymouth forged ahead, 27-20.

But, Crestline came right back and Mike Zara climaxed a drive with a plunge to paydirt from one yard away with 2:46 remaining on the clock.

The Bulldogs, however, were thwarted on an attempted run for the two-point PAT which left them one point short of Plymouth which was able to hold on the rest of the way.

Crestline had the edge in statistics with 286 yards total offense including 223 on the ground while the Big Red had 179 total yards and 115 rushing.

COLUMBIA STATION — Western Reserve had to come from behind twice to record their fifth straight opening night victory over Columbia Station, 18-9.

The hosts scored first on a one-yard plunge in the second period by Bob Vibonese for a 6-0 lead.

It wasn't until the second half that the Roughriders got the lead for the first time as Dane Burke bulled in from the one. Scott Keith tallied the two-point PAT try for an 8-6 lead.

Then, Columbia Station added a 19-yard field goal by Dan Wood in the final stanza to regain the lead at 9-8.

The Riders proceeded to put a strong drive together with Keith going the final nine yards for the score. Burke ran the two-pointer to give the visitors a 16-9 edge.

Western added two more points later in the same period when they tackled Dan Wood in the end zone for a safety.

Keith was the leading ground gainer as he collected an even 100 yards. In all the Rough Riders grounded out 192 yards in 41 attempts. They were 0-for-2 in the passing department.

Western travels to Firelands Friday for their next encounter before jumping in to Firelands Conference play the following weekend.

Schofield slam defeats Tigers

ANAHEIM, Calif. (UPI) — Dick Schofield's grand slam with two out capped an eight-run California rally in the bottom of the ninth inning to carry the Angels to a 13-12 victory Friday night over the Detroit Tigers.

Trailing 12-5, Schofield opened the California uprising with a single off Randy O'Neal. After Rick Burleson flied out, Wally Joyner walked and Brian Downing singled to load the bases. Jack Howell then delivered a two-run double to chase O'Neal in favor of Willie Hernandez.

Hernandez promptly gave up back-to-back, run-scoring singles to George Hendrick and Bobby Grich to make it 12-9 before recording the second out on a force play by Gary Pettis. After Pettis took second without drawing a throw, pinch hitter Ruppert Jones walked on a full count to load the bases. Hernandez, 7-6, threw two strikes before Schofield drove his 12th homer to make a winner of Doug Corbett, 3-2.
