# Tough day for golfers in regionals

# Norwalk's Kaye lone state qualfier with 76 in AA at Thunderbird

It was a disappointing day for area golf teams Friday, but not for Norwalk's Greg Kaye.

Regional competition in Classes A and AA were held for three area teams and the same number of individuals, but only Kaye qualified for the state tournament at Ohio State University's Scarlet course

Two Sandusky Bay Conference teams had won district crowns last week. St. Mary's in Class A at Green Hills and Huron in AA at Mansfield's Possum Run

However, neither team made it out of the regional, along with Norwalk, another Class AA entry.

In Class A competition at Hinckley, St. Mary's C.C. finished third among the eight schools, and missed the cutoff by six strokes. The top two teams advance to the state and the Panthers were third for the second year in a row

Mogadore won the title with 338 strkes and Newbiury was second at 343. St. Mary's had 349, Columbia 350, Middlefield Cardinal 354, Colonel Crawford and Hawken 356 and Buckeye Central

Steve Fitzpatrick had 44-41-85 and Andy Koelsch 43-43-86 to lead the Panthers. Jude Manuella carded 48-39-87, Rich Finneran 45-46-91 and Matt York

"Jude and Matt came back on the second nine they played, but it wasn't enough. We were missed by two strokes lat year and six today," coach John Veith said.

Chris Oliva of Berlin Center was medalist with 36-40-76.

Plymouth's Larry Trout qualified as an individual and posted 43-42-85 and also failed to qualify. The top three players on non-qualifying teams earned state bids.

Kaye had a sensational front nine with two-under-par 33, then slipped to 43 on the tougher back side. However, the Norwalk senior still tied for medal honors in the field at five-over-par 76.

Huron, playing on its hometown course at Thunderbird Hills, was well back in the 12-school field in which the top three teams advanced to Columbus.

The Tigers were 8th with a 336 total as Upper Sandusky ran away from the field with 315 strokes, followed by Gilmour Academy with 316 and James Garfield

Kenston and Lorain Catholic finished with 330, Norwalk 331, Napoleon 332, Huron 336, Elyria Catholic and Rossford 343, Wauseon 345, and Keystone 348.

Jay Weyer was low for the Tigers with 38-42-80 and Rob McKay added 41-40-81. Mike Miller registered 42-42-84, John Springer 45-46--91 and Jeff Majestic 45-50-95.

For Norwalk, in addition to Kaye's fine 76, Jon Mattox had 40-42-82, Matt Simons 44-40-84, Jay Mattox 43-46-89 and Gary Rock 43-47-90.

Two other area golfers competed as individuals. Marty Hippler of Margaretta, a state qualifier last year, missed out with 39-44-83 and Bill Babione of Willard also failed to make the grade with 39-42-81.

There was a three-way tie for medal honors at 76 involving Kaye, Mark Phelps of Garfield and Bill Knapp of Upper Sandusky who had 37-39--76.

Also for the champion Rams, Steve Salaroff had 39-39-78, Stacey Hunt 37-43-80, Scott Newell 36-45-81 and Matt Patchett 42-44-86

The Class AAA regional competition is today at Mount Vernon with Vermilion among the participating schools.
