

Black River finishes at 10-0

Black River may have ended its season Friday night.

But, what a season the Pirates enjoyed.

For the fourth time in six years, Black River carts off the hardware in the Firelands Conference.

Following a 14-6 win over pesky New London, the Pirates close out the season unbeaten at 10-0 overall and 8-0 in the FC.

It's the third perfect season for Black River since 1977.

But, the Pirates will be sitting at home for the playoffs as the Division 4 school didn't earn enough computer points.

Black River needed to stage a second half comeback to finish with a perfect season.

New London, closing at 3-7 overall and 2-6 in the conference, led by a 6-0 score at intermission following a first period touchdown pass of five yards from sophomore quarterback Robbie Lavengood to Jarrod Kipp.

But, a pair of second half touchdowns by Jim Addington clinched the win for Black River.

Monroeville 27 Crestview 10

MONROEVILLE — Rick Bryant and John Anderson each scored twice as Monroeville closed with a 27-10 win over Ashland Crestview.

Monroeville, 7-3 overall, jumped out to a 12-0 lead in the first period on a 29-yard run by Bryant and a 20-yard run by Anderson.

And, the same two reached the end zone in the second period as the Eagles built a 27-3 lead by intermission.

Anderson, who had 165 yards on just 11 carries, scored on a 71-yard scamper with 11:47 left in the period and Bryant came back in the final minute, going over from 2 yards away.

Plymouth 15 Mapleton 13

PLYMOUTH — Plymouth scored with no time remaining on the clock in the first half to take a 15-7 halftime lead, then relied on its defense in the second half to earn a 15-13 win over Mapleton in another Firelands game.

Mapleton had the ball three times in Plymouth territory the fourth quarter alone, but couldn't score.

St. Paul 14 W. Reserve 7

COLLINS — Norwalk St. Paul finished over .500 for the first time since 1982 by downing Western Reserve to close out the season Friday.

The win lifts the Flyers to 6-4 on the season and 5-3 in the Firelands Conference while the

Roughriders fall to 6-4 overall and 5-3 in the league.

St. Paul jumped out to a 7-0 lead on a 2-yard touchdown run from Craig Coe with Larry Fisher booting the extra point.

Western knotted the score in the second quarter when Bryan Yaussey raced 11 yards for the score with David Good hitting the point-after, but Greg Rogers bulled over from the one late in the third quarter for the game-winner for the Flyers.

Mahorn sent to Philly

ST. PAUL, Minn. — Rick Mahorn said he had mixed emotions about Friday's trade that sent him from the Minnesota Timberwolves to Philadelphia for the 76ers' first-round draft choice in 1990 and second-round draft choices in 1991 and 1992.

"The thing is, I never got the opportunity to perform for the Minnesota fans like I knew I could have," Mahorn said in a telephone interview from Italy, where he has been — and continues to — negotiate with a team in Verona.

"It's a sad note there that things didn't work out between the Timberwolves and myself. The only losers are the fans. But I've got to look out for me. Philadelphia is an up-and-coming team, an established team. It's nice to go to a good organization."

The trade is conditional on Mahorn reporting to Philadelphia and passing a physical. Mahorn, the Timberwolves' top pick in the expansion draft from the Detroit Pistons, said he would be in Philadelphia Monday for the physical.

His agent, Al Waldon, will return from Italy on Tuesday and meet with Sixers officials on Wednesday.
