

# FAN EXPECTATIONS

It is the expectation of the Plymouth-Shiloh Board of Education that all spectators demonstrate sportsmanship towards players, coaches, game officials, and other fans.

Examples of unacceptable behavior include but are not limited to the following:


- \*Threatening actions or verbal abuse of players, fans, coaches, and game officials.
- \*Unauthorized entry onto the playing area, team bench area or locker room
- \*Throwing objects, or disrespect toward anyone.

A fan who uses physical assault at an athletic contest will be prosecuted and denied admission to all future contests until he / she is reinstated by the district superintendent.

Written notification will be given to the offendant, stating the offense and resulting consequences. The fan may appeal the decision to the Board of Education or its designee, by notifying the appropriate Athletic Director within 5 working days of receipt of his / her notification letter.


An athletic contest is not a place for alcoholic beverages. People wishing to drink or those obviously under the influence of alcohol will be asked to leave the premises.

The Athletic Department and Control Board of Plymouth High School has instituted a NO PASS-OUT policy for all extra-curricular activities and contests. This includes trips to automobiles and for the sake of smoking. If you leave the building, and go outside, you will be asked to re-pay for admittance. This includes those individuals that have purchased season passes and those in possession of Firelands Conference passes. These particular passes allow the bearer to enter the game for the evening one time. Each subsequent time, a ticket must be bought.






Tickets for <u>league</u> games, in football, volleyball, basketball, and wrestling are \$5.00 at the door for adults and students.

# THE TEN COMMANDMENTS FOR PARENTS OF ATHLETIC CHILDREN

- Make sure your child knows that win or lose, scared or heroic you love them, appreciate their efforts, and are not disappointed in them. This will allow them to do their best without fear of failure. Be the person in their life they can look to for constant positive reinforcement.
- 2. Try your best to be completely honest about your child's athletic ability, their competitive attitude, their sportsmanship, and their actual skill level.
- 3. Be helpful but don't coach them. It's tough not to, but it is a lot tougher for the child to be flooded with advice, and critical instruction.
- 4. Teach them to enjoy the thrill of competition, to be "out there trying," to be working to improve their skills and attitudes. Help them develop the feeling for competing, for trying hard, for having fun.
- 5. Try not to relive your athletic life through your child in a way that creates pressure: you lost as well as won. You were frightened, you backed off at times, you were not always heroic. Don't pressure your child because of your pride. Athletic children need their parents so you must not withdraw. Just remember their thinking, feeling, sensitive free spirit out there in that uniform who needs a lot of understanding, especially when their world turns bad. If they are comfortable with you win or lose they're on their way to maximum achievement and enjoyment.
- 6. Don't compete with the coach. If the coach becomes an authority figure, it will run from enchantment to disenchantment, with your athlete.
- 7. Don't compare the skill, courage, or attitude of your child with other members of the team, at least within their hearing.
- 8. Get to know the coach(s), then you can be assured that his philosophy, attitudes, ethics and knowledge are such that you are happy to have your child under his leadership.
- 9. Always remember that children tend to exaggerate, both when praised and when criticized. Temper your reaction and investigate before over reacting.
- 10. Make a point of understanding courage, and the fact that it is relative. Some of us can climb mountains, and are afraid to fly. Some of us will fly, but turn to jelly if a bee approaches. Everyone is frightened in certain areas. Explain that courage is not the absence of fear, but a means of doing something in spite of fear and discomfort.
