Shelby Dominates at Mehock

Was there ever any doubt?

"We could have done better," said Shelby track coach Larry Baldridge.

Baldridge is a perfectionist. But if his Whippets had done any better Saturday in the Class AA Sectional track meet at Mehock Field they could have redshirted themselves for the District next week at Bowling Green and just advanced right to Columbus.

Shelby shouldn't have bothered to show up Saturday. The Whippets should have simply had their whole team including trainers and water boys placed in the fastests heats at the State Meet. The meet would have been much more competitive.

The Whippets scored 139 points, beating runnerup Huron with 84 and third-place Lexington at 36. They did it with six firsts and qualified with 17 chances to cop the District crown.

"The field events got us rolling," said Baldridge, whose youthful appearence denies his coaching excellence. "Dwight (Downs) came through and surprised me by beating (Jim) Titlow from Clear Fork in the discus and we placed some of our younger kids in the long jump and high jump.

Downs won his specialty, the shot put, in a distance of 53-4 ¼, then flipped the discus 154-1 top top Titlow by over a foot. By the time the field events were over, Shelby already had 50 points,
