

Ontario Wins Three-way Meet

Ontario, on the strength in field events, won a three-way track and field meet over Mt. Gilead and Malabar yesterday.

Ontario piled up 66 points. Mt. Gilead 59 and Malabar 32. In other track and field meets, Crestview and Shelby each defeated Clear Fork and Bucyrus respectively by 99-28 scores.

South Central humbled Norwalk St. Paul, 87-40; Fredericktown pasted Northmor, 75-52; Willard blazed over Norwalk, 78-49; Lexington smashed Plymouth (30½) and Crestline (13) with 114½ points and Highland smothered Lucas, 95-23.
