Buckeyes Continue In First

COLUMBUS (AP) — Ohio State, with three players among the top four individuals, extended its team lead in the Kepler Invitational golf tournament Saturday with a 36-hole score of 748.

The defending champion Buckeyes held a 24-stroke lead over Marshall, at 772, going into Sunday's final 18-hole round. Kent State was third at 779 and Illinois fourth at 782.

Ohio State sophomore Ralph Guarasci and Mick Soli of Northern Illinois shared the individual lead with 145. Guarasci shot a 36-73 Saturday and Soli carved a par 36-36-72 on the 6,900-yard OSU Scarlet course.

Other top individuals were Ohio State's Mark Balen and Craig Carson, both at 147; Scott Davis of Marshall, 148; Ned Weaver of Kent State, 151; and Julius Boros Jr. of Iowa, Harold Payne of Marshall and Tom Fairgrieve of Ohio State, 152s.

Low rounds of 71s were carded Saturday by Davis and Rod Loesch (Mansfield, O.) of Ohio State. Mel McIntyre of Toledo, Friday's medalist with a 69, soared to an 84.

Ashland and Crestview Win Crowns in Relays

ASHLAND — Ashland and Crestview were winners at the 13th annual Ashland-Hillsdale boys invitational track and field meet Satur-day at Ashland College's Sar-ver Field.

The Ashland Arrows were victorious in the Class AAA meet, rolling up 96 points. Runner-up was Wadsworth with 78 1/2. Mansfield Madison took fifth with 43.

Taking five firsts and placing in each event, the Arrows won their seventh crown out-right. Ashland tied for the championship in 1973.

Two records were broken in the big schools class.

Three were broken in the Class AA-A battle with the Crestview Cougars claiming two of them.

The Cougars won the AA-A meet by piling up 108 points. Runner-up was Fred-ericktown with 99. The Fred-dies recorded the meet's only other record.

Crestview's record-setting performances came in the long jump (60 feet) and the 440-yard relay (45.9). Fred-ericktown's record was in the shuttle hurdles relay (61.7).

In winning, Crestview won seven of nine running events and two of five in the field. The victory was Crestview's second outright title. The Cou-gars shared first in the meet's first running in 1964.
