St. Paul, Brown, Cooke reach state

COLUMBUS — St. Paul, plus Todd Brown and Logan Cooke as individuals, reached the pinnacle in golf with a trip to Columbus for the state tournament in October.

The Flyers, behind Andrew Hanneman, recorded fourth overall with a 625 in Division III.

Hanneman fired a two-day total of 146 for second overall and a spot on the all-Ohio list.

Other scores for St. Paul included Shane Theisen at 155, Tyler Alge and Drake Toney with 162 each and Rob Mansfield at 177.

Meanwhile, Cooke, the son of Millstone Hills owners Stu and Kelli Cooke, collected a 170.

"I just need to practice on the stuff I'm not great at right now," he said.

Meanwhile, Brown, who played on the Truckers' state team in 2002, shot a 158, which was good for 17th overall in Division I.

Brown closed the day with a one under over the last seven holes.

"I finished on a good note and that made the feeling a lot better," he said. "There's a fine line between being a great golfer and a good golfer."

Brown ended his career as a four-time Northern Ohio League selection, three-time all-district choice, plus the individual showings.
